**Membership Fee Schedule**  
**Year 2005/2006**

**FEE**

1. **Federal and Provincial Governments and Federal and Provincially Funded Ministries, Authorities, or Councils** **\$7,500**  
( Note: This includes membership of organizations such as , Western Economic Diversification, Northern British Columbia Caucus, Northern Alberta Development Council, Transport Canada.)

2. **Local and Regional Governments including - Incorporated Municipalities, \* Regional Districts ,Municipal Districts, County's, Regional Municipalities.**  
• ( Membership is exclusive to unincorporated communities and their aggregate population in the respective Regional Districts)

Based on Population:

- Populations less then 1500 **\$ 250**
- Populations between 1500 and 2500 **\$ 500**
- Populations between 2500 and 10,000 **\$1,500**
- Populations between 10,000 and 25,000 **\$2,500**
- Populations greater then 25,000 **\$5,000**

(NOTE: If a community Economic Development Association/Society/Organization joins instead of or on behalf of the municipality they will be assessed in the municipal classification and pay per population as above. If they are not representing the municipality because the municipality is already a member; the Economic Development Association/Society/Organization pays as per the Professional Organization Schedule below)

3. **Business and/or Economic Development Corporations, Authorities or Organisations**
- Boards of Trade & Chambers of Commerce **\$ 500**
  - Community Futures Development Corporations **\$ 500**
  - Other Associations **\$ 500**

***Corporate Classifications***

4. **Corporations ( Revenues over \$5 million )** **\$2,500**
5. **Small Businesses (Revenues under \$5,000,000)**
- Businesses with under 50 employees **\$ 250**
  - Businesses with under 100 employees **\$ 500**
  - Business with over 100 employees **\$1,000**

**6. Non-Government, Volunteer-based Citizen Groups and or Coalitions** **\$250**

(NOTE: This would include the Peace River Agriculture Strategic Planning Society, North West Communities Coalition etc,)

**9. Educational Institutions** **\$500**

**10. Reciprocal Membership** **No Fee**

(NOTE: This would only be offered to organisations that are involved in complimentary endeavours that advance northern transportation and economic development. )

**11. Honorary Life Membership** **No Fee**

(NOTE: The criteria for this would be one of past service to the organisation. This would be offered to a member after approval by the Board. )

**There will be no individual memberships.**

**New member classification:** It is recommended that all new member applications come before the Board of Directors with a recommendation from the Secretariat as to the Classification for each. The Board Decision on classification will be provided by the Secretariat to new members after each Board Meeting. New members will be sent a letter of welcome, a free Conference/AGM registration and an information package on NCDC. They will be profiled in the NCDC Corridor Report.
